8-2-21 2133 hrs.

Police investigated an incident in which a male victim reported being accosted on the unit block N. Brookside Rd. The male reported that his bike was then stolen by two males who were in a vehicle. As the victim and a friend left the area using Springfield Rd, they were again approached by the same two males. The males forced the victim into their vehicle and drove to a local park where they stole the male's backpack and physically assaulted him. Officers were able to identify the suspects as a juvenile male from Morton and Zachary Priestley 22 yrs. old from Eddystone. On 8-3-21 the juvenile was taken into custody after being observed in Springfield. He was charged and transported to a juvenile facility. An arrest warrant was obtained for Priestley, and he was taken into custody at his home on 8-6. He was arraigned and transported to Delaware County Prison.

A 40 yr. old male from Glenolden was taken into custody after being observed loitering in the area of the 900 block Greenbriar Ln. intoxicated. Witnesses reported the male had been in the area all morning acting erratically. He appeared under the influence of narcotics.
