12-1-21 0912 hrs.

Officers were called by a witness who observed a pickup truck strike traffic signs on Baltimore Pk. and continue to Barker Rd. where it struck a parked vehicle. Officers located the pickup truck in the area of Woodland Av. and Baltimore Pk. The driver, 31 yrs. old from Secane, was found to be under the influence of an opioid.
