5-18-26 2100 hrs.

A resident of the 300 block N. Rolling Rd. reported a group of juveniles broke a glass pane on a storm door by banging and ran from the area.

5-19-26 1308 hrs.

A 34 yr. old female from Clifton Heights will be charged with Retail Theft after being found by security at Target at the mall stealing over \$308 worth of health and beauty supplies and grocery products. She is also suspected of prior thefts from the store.

5-19-26 1935 hrs.

A resident reported that while his Tesla truck was parked at the municipal lot on the 100 block Saxer Av., a group of young males poured a milkshake on the rear door.

Officers were called to the Kay Jewelers inside the mall for a burglary that had just occurred involving a male subject who had used a hammer to smash a glass display case and removed a watch.
