9-11-23 0937 hrs.

Target security at the mall reported observing a male steal multiple small electronics and leave the store. Responding officers observed the suspect walking in the area of the 1100 block Baltimore Pk. and after a short foot chase took him into custody. The male, 45 yrs. old from Glenolden, was found to have active arrest warrants from Delaware County. He was turned over to Delaware County Sheriffs, and charges for Retail Theft will be filed.
